Hidden coves, tidal pools, and ancient cave systems line the coastline, inviting exploration and reflecting the area's rich archaeological heritage. These caves are among the oldest inhabited sites in southern Africa, revealing evidence of early human life dating back tens of thousands of years. Today, De Kelders remains peaceful and unspoilt, offering quiet streets, scenic coastal paths, and a strong sense of community. Its close proximity to Gansbaai adds cultural depth through a long tradition of fishing and seafaring. This is more than a home — it is a lifestyle opportunity in one of the Western Cape's most scenic and historically rich coastal villages.











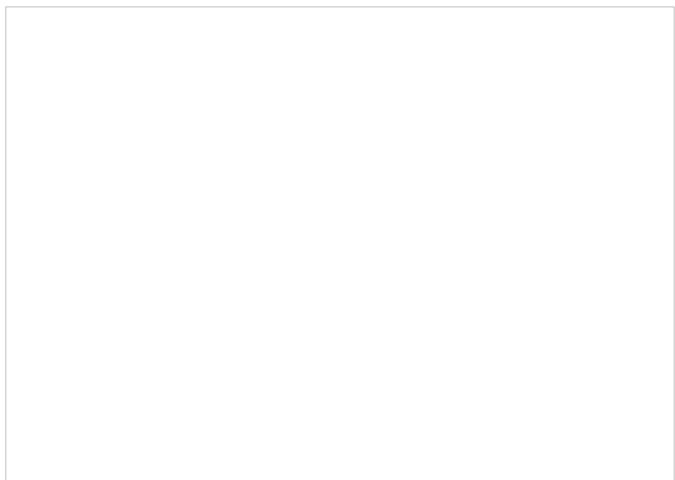






















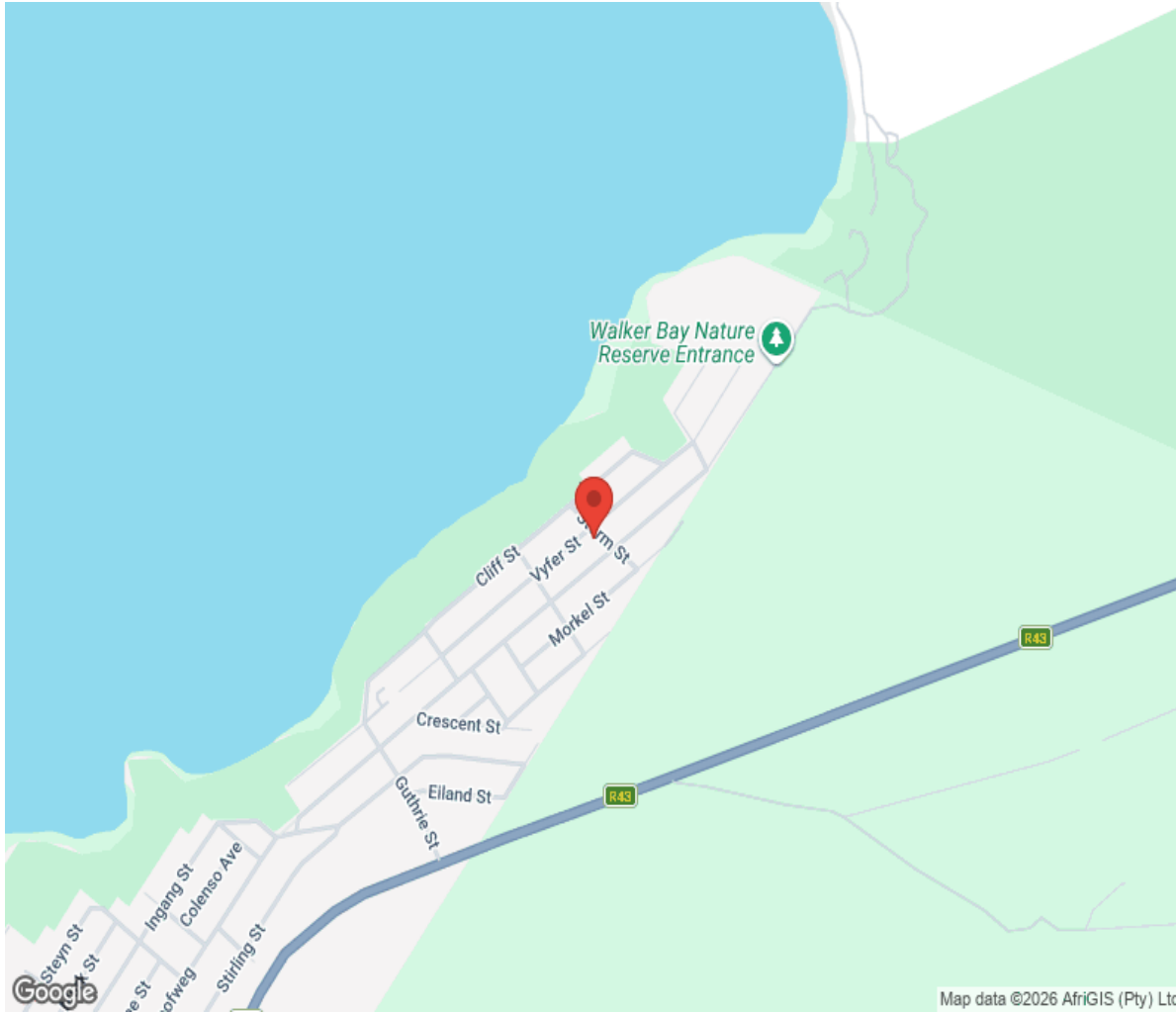
