The location is a true driver of sustained rental performance. Situated just minutes from the University of Southern California (USC) which is home to over 40,000 students and steps from Exposition Park, the Natural History Museum, and the LA Memorial Coliseum, this property benefits from constant housing demand from students, faculty, and working professionals. 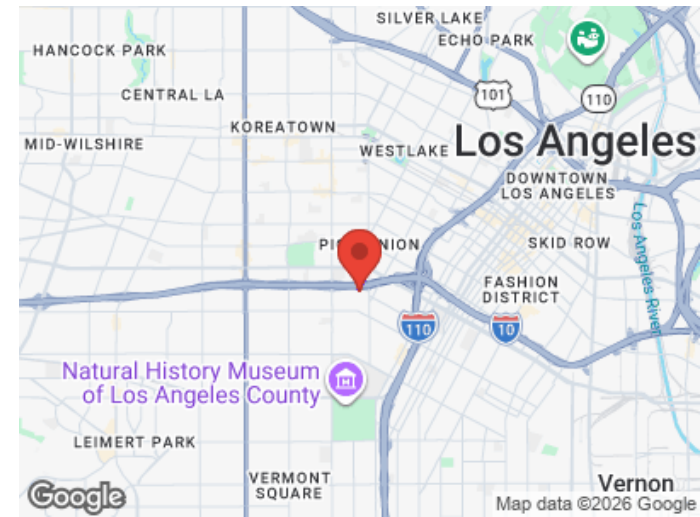
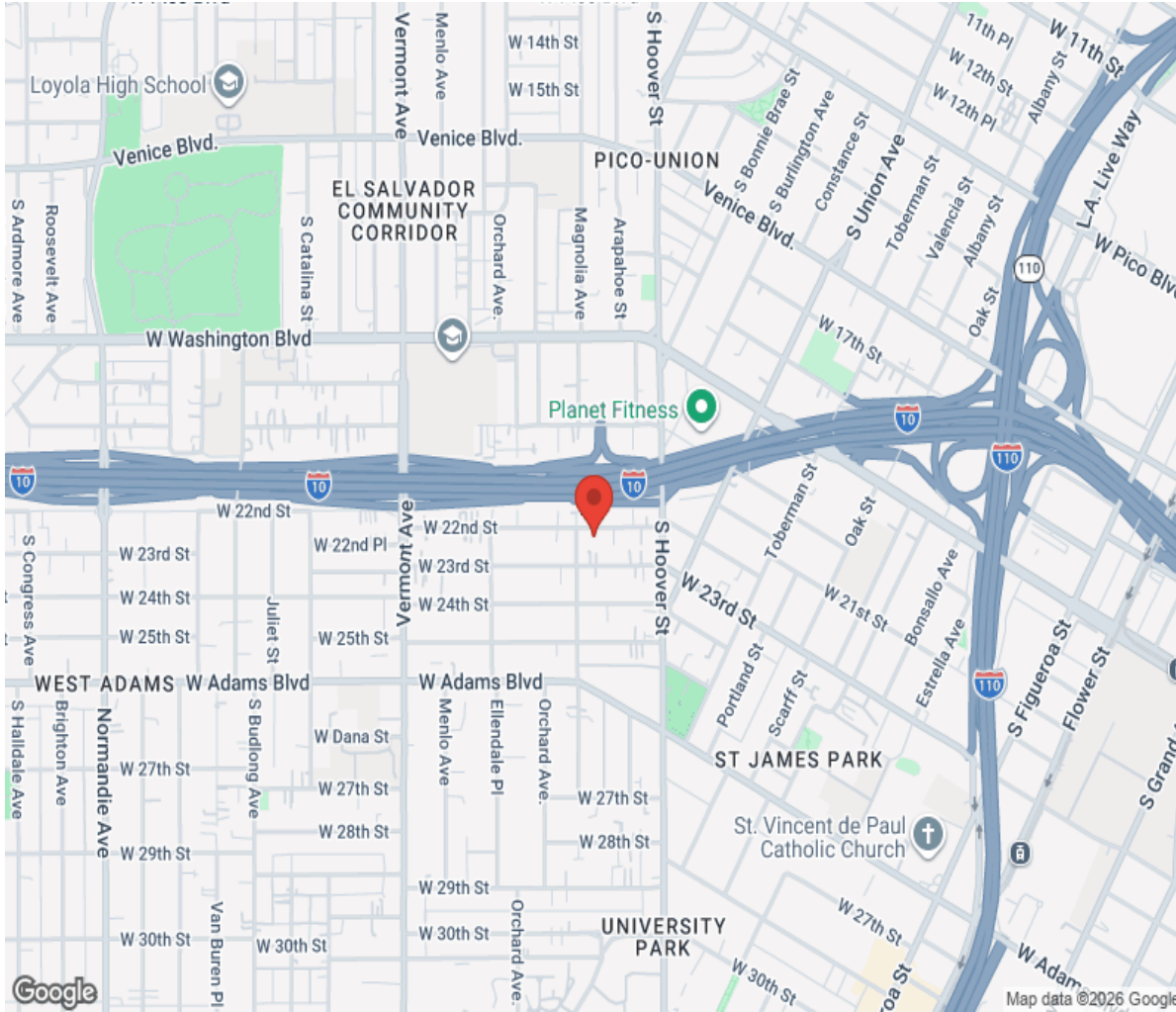
